Washington, DC - Congressman Travis Childers (D-MS) issued the following statement regarding suspicious gas price spikes in North Mississippi:

"As many of you are aware, gas prices in the East of the First Congressional District have dramatically spiked in past 24 hours. Yesterday, prices were around \$3.55 per gallon, and today they have reached nearly five dollars per gallon. This tremendous increase does not seem legitimate to me, and I am watching things closely to evaluate the cause.

"I am also working with local, state, and federal organizations to try to resolve this issue, and have sent an e-newsletter with helpful resources to constituents who have requested this information. North Mississippians are encouraged to contact our Capitol Hill and district offices with questions and concerns."
